Giovanni, a renowned Italian filmmaker, is about to start shooting a political film. But between his marriage in crisis, his co-producer on the verge of bankruptcy and the rapidly changing film industry, everything seems to be working against him! Always on the edge, Giovanni will have to rethink his way of doing things if he wants to lead his little world towards a bright tomorrow.

Director's Intention Note


A film about cinema. The story of a filmmaker whose life has always been punctuated by cinema and whose films have always accompanied his own life. Giovanni is making a film set in 1956, at the time of the Soviet invasion of Hungary. He firmly believes in this project: he is convinced that it is necessary to tell the story of the Italian Communist Party at that time and how it missed the opportunity to break away from the Soviet Union, to finally take an independent path. But today, no one remembers these events, the world has changed and so has the way films are made. While Giovanni is convinced that he is making a political film, his actress thinks the opposite: according to her, Giovanni is making a love film and doesn't realize it (and maybe she is right). Giovanni's wife Paola secretly goes to a psychoanalyst to find the courage to leave him. Moreover, for the first time, she produces a film that is not Giovanni's: an action film by a young up-and-coming director.

Although the world around him is increasingly difficult to decipher and accept, Giovanni does not want to give in to a disappointing reality. And above all, he does not want to give up the dream of being able to change it. And if life and history do not allow him to do so, then cinema, with its contagious force and energy, transforms reality and makes dreams possible. So, while he is busy on set, he is preparing and imagining two other films: the love story of a couple over several decades and THE SWIMMER, based on the short story by John Cheever. As if the empty gaps in life should always be filled by cinema.

I wanted the film to follow the flow of Giovanni's thoughts and emotions. For this, while telling a story (or rather several stories), I needed a wide and free script, capable of containing different layers, tones and styles. The film goes through different crisis and then overcomes them thanks to cinema, which has the magic power to make us rediscover lightness and the desire to be happy. In spite of everything.
